We are offering 30 hours free funding for eligible families. Please ask at the office if you think your child can take up the offer

We have a few spaces for 15 hours for 2 and 3 year olds. If you know anyone who needs a place please speak to staff in the office



All funded children are offered 15 hours at our nursery

or
PM 12.45-3.30

In addition to this all children are offered one extra dinner session from 11:30—12:45

This covers the total education entitlement of 15 hours per week

We use Early Years Pupil Premium money to partially fund the cost of one dinner per week for all 3 and 4 year olds

We are not able to use EYPP funding for 2 year olds so there is a charge of £2 per dinner until your child is 3 years old

We are planning transition sessions for parents of children who will be moving up to school in September. This will help inform you about how to prepare your child for the next stage of their education
