PM 12.45-3.30

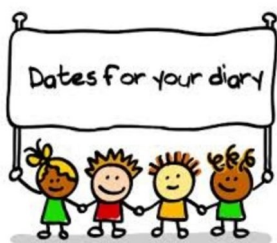
All children are offered four of these sessions = 11 hours

We do not stock any spare nappies, so that your child can be comfortable we need spare nappies to enable us to care for you child/children
