## How to .... Make play dough

Here is a simple recipe for making homemade playdough with your children, we use this in nursery



- **2 cups of flour**
- **1 cup of salt**
- **1 tablespoon of cooking oil**
- **1 cup of cold water**

**Mix the ingredients together**

**If it is too wet add a little more flour  
and have lots of fun!!!**

Could we please ask that only nappies, pull ups and wipes are left in bags.

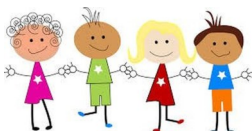
If children require medication, it should be given to a member of staff.
